This production sees a number of new faces to Burton Joyce Players, and the production team wishes you a pleasant evening.

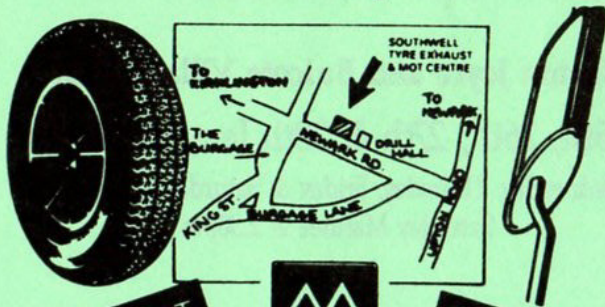

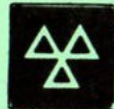
